

Extension of Recertifications/Interims	Allows DHS to adjust the expiration for certification periods expiring in March, April and May 2020 and extend the certification period of these households for 6 months until September, October and November 2020. The State will also adjust/waive the interim reporting requirement for households with a report due between March through May 2020 and for households whose certification period is extended under this waiver.	Implemented
Emergency Allotments	Provides all SNAP households not currently receiving the maximum SNAP benefit allotment for their household size a supplement to bring them up to the maximum benefit amount for the months of March and April 2020. This is expected to continue throughout the emergency upon approval by FNS.	Implemented
Interview Waiver	Blanket waiver provided to States that allows the following: 1) a non-expedited household is not required to complete an interview prior to approval, provided the applicant's identity has been verified and all other mandatory verification have been completed, 2) a face-to-face interview is not required to be granted upon the household's request at application or recertification, 3) households that are eligible for expedited service are not required to complete an interview prior to approval, provided that an applicant's identity has been identified and an attempt has been made to contact the household for an interview.	Implemented
ABAWD Waiver	All communities now waived for ABAWD work requirements except if an ABAWD is expressly offered a work opportunity.	Implemented
Waiver of Student Work Requirements	Waiver to allow students of higher education who are impacted due to COVID-19 to qualify for SNAP regardless of employment status. Waiver would allow the agency to waive the 20 hour per week work requirement for students in higher education.	Denied 4/10
Waiver Overpayment Recoupments	Suspension of collections of overpayments to maximize household benefit access	Implemented
P-EBT	Provides the value of missed school meals (\$5.70/day per child) to SNAP households and non-SNAP households.	Implementing
Accept Self-Attestation of Income if no verification available	Accept customer's self-attestation of income if the agency is not available to verify the income via another source.	Denied 4/10
Expand Restaurant Meals Program	For all SNAP households, temporarily allow participation in the Restaurant Meals Program (RMP) in order to purchase prepared meals at FNS authorized restaurants, regardless of age, disability, or whether the individual is experiencing homelessness. Additionally, allow RMP purchases to include take-out, to-go, drive-thru and delivery options.	Pending
Telephonic Signatures Waiver	Permission to implement functionality to accept new applications over the phone	Approved/In Process
