Thank you for inquiring about the **Rhode Island Organ Transplant Fund (OTF)** at the **Department of Human Services (DHS)**.

The Organ Transplant Fund was established to help Rhode Island residents and their families with **non-reimbursed costs related to organ transplants**. While the fund does not cover the full cost of a transplant, it provides financial support for eligible expenses such as insurance premiums, hospital and medical services, prescription drugs, and out-of-state living expenses. Assistance is subject to income eligibility and a **lifetime reimbursement limit of \$15,000**.

Enclosed you will find program materials, including program application and a brochure summarizing eligibility requirements, covered services, and how to apply.

Please complete the attached application and submit along with the below required forms:

- OTF Application
- IRS W-9 form: Request for Taxpayer Identification and Certification and requested supporting documentation such as
- Current Proof of Income (30 days)
- Proof of RI Residency for at least 1 year prior to diagnoses
- Completed Medical diagnosis form
