

CHILD CARE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM VERIFICATION CHECKLIST

The following list includes documents that you may need for benefit approval. The Department of Human Services may ask for additional documents if needed. Please note: the same document may be used to verify more than one category, for example, a driver's license can verify identity and address.

1. TO VERIFY YOUR IDENTITY, CITIZENSHIP AND/OR IMMIGRATION STATUS (REQUIRED FOR THE CHILD ONLY)

TO VERIFY RELATIONSHIPS AMONG HOUSEHOLD MEMBERS All that apply: Adoption papers or records Hospital or public health records of birth or parentage Child support paternity records Marriage license/tribal marriage certificates Divorce/custody papers Guardianship papers or records 8. TO VERIFY YOUR DISABILITY All that apply: Complete DHS form C1B Letter from your doctor Statement of disability-related benefits (e.g., Supplemental Security Income (SSI), Social Security Disability Insurance (SSID),

Retirement, Survivors, and Disability Insurance (RSDI), etc.)
