Quick Tips

- Create an online DHS Customer Portal account at <https://healthyrhode.ri.gov> where you can see your notices, upload documents and apply for benefits on the DHS Customer Portal.
- Download the HealthyRhode app on your smartphone at the App Store® or Google Play Store®. Search for the app using “HealthyRhode.”
- If your Electronic Benefit Transfer (EBT) card is lost, stolen or damaged, call the Customer Service number: 1-888-979-9939 (available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week). To check your balance and get other account information online, go to www.ebtedge.com
- Dialing 2-1-1 can connect you with information on SNAP outreach, housing, food, affordable childcare, assistance setting up Customer Portal accounts and using the HealthyRhode mobile app, tech resources, and much more.
