

PROPOSED ADOPTION OF TANF STATE PLAN

In accordance to the Rhode Island General Laws (RIGL) 40-5.2 and 42 USC 9008, notice is hereby given that the Department of Human Services proposes the following TANF State Plan: **2022-2023 Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Block Grant**. A public hearing will be held to consider the proposed plan on Tuesday, March 21, 2023, at 1:00 P.M., conducted by the RI Department of Human Services, **at the RI Department of Human Services, Louis Pasteur Building, Building #57, 25 Howard Avenue, 1st Floor Room #110, Cranston, RI 02920 in the West Wing Conference Room**. The hearing will begin at 1:00 P.M. and will conclude when the last speaker finishes testimony or at 2:00 P.M., whichever comes first. The RI Department of Human Services, Louis Pasteur Building is accessible to the handicapped.
