Rhode Island Works (RIW) Screener

Rhode Island Works (RIW) is a cash assistance program for families with children under age 18 or children who live with their caretaker relatives. Benefit eligibility is determined by the Rhode Island Department of Human Services (DHS). Use this screening tool to help determine whether you might be eligible for RI Works benefits. Please note only DHS can determine eligibility.

1. Does your family have children under age 18, live in Rhode Island, and need cash assistance while supporting your work and education goals?

You may be eligible for RI Works, or cash assistance. Families eligible for RI Works may get a cash payment, transportation, child care, and employment training assistance as part of a broader support to strengthen and stabilize their household. Parents will receive case management support to help them complete their education, skill/credential obtainment, and/or help with creating a pathway to a well-paying job.

- 2. Will your family be eligible for RI Works? Only DHS can determine whether you will be able to receive cash assistance, but the questions below may help you to decide if you want to apply.
